### Data protection

#### What are cookies?

#### What type of cookies do we use?

Analysis cookies: These are cookies that, whether processed by us or by third parties, allow us to quantify the number of users and carry out the measurement and statistical analysis of how users use the service offered. We examine your browsing on our website in order to improve the provision of products or services that we make available to you.

Advertising cookies: These are cookies that, when processed by us or by third parties, allow us to manage more effectively the offer of advertising spaces that exist on the website, being able to analyse your browsing habits and show you adverts related to your browsing profile.

#### What does it mean not to authorize the use of cookies?

If you prefer not to allow cookies, you can disable cookies in the internet browser you use, but you should be aware that it may prevent some pages or web features from being displayed correctly.

How can I manage cookies?
